Myanmar is an all year round destination. Hilly regions in the north and northeast enjoy cool temperature weather. Rainfall is also very low in central regions during the rainy season.

Population

The Republic of the Union of Myanmar has a population of over 60 million. The major racial groups are Bamar, Kachin, Kayah, Kayin, Chin, Mon, Rakhine and Shan. The people are called Myanmar.

Language

Myanmar, several dialects and English.

Religion

Over 80 percent of Myanmar embrace Theravada Buddhism. There are Christians, Muslims, Hindus and some animists.

Currency

The local currency is the “Kyat” which is divided into 100 pyas. Kyat notes are issued in denominations of 1,5,10,15,20,45,50,90,100, 200,500,1000,5000 and 10000.

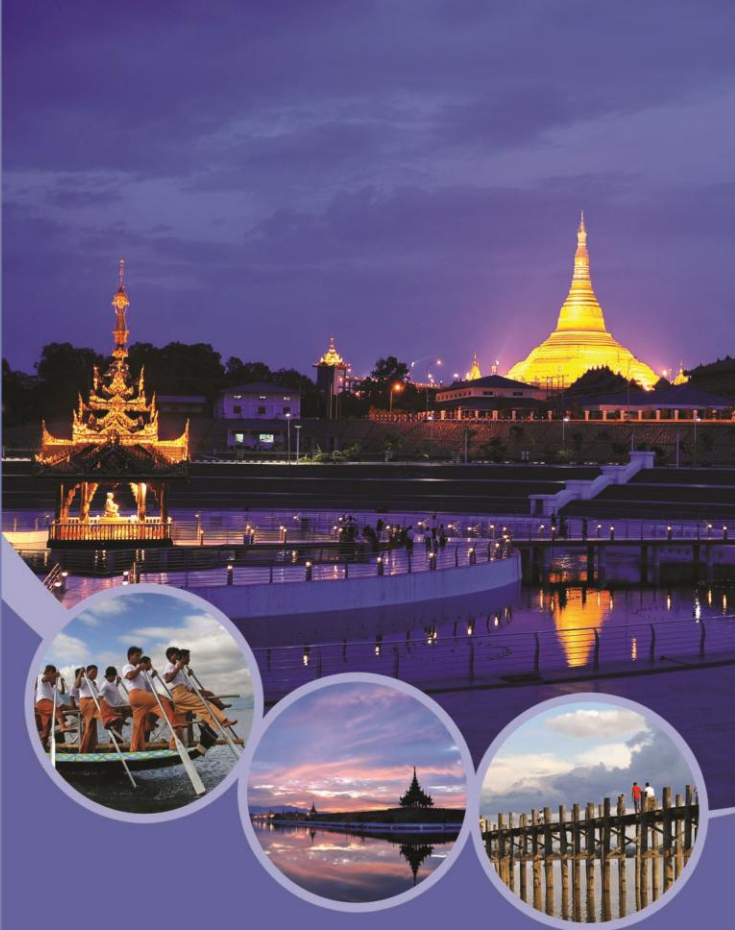

Visa Formalities

A valid Passport with Entry Visa is required for all visitors. The entry visa to Myanmar is applicable at Myanmar Embassies and Consulate General Offices abroad and it is valid for 28 days.

Overland Entry

Overland entry is permitted with valid visa for international visitors at designated check points along Thailand-Myanmar border. Prior Permission is required for package tour travellers at China-Myanmar border and India-Myanmar border.

Business Visa *US \$ 50, 70 days

Entry Visa * US \$ 40, 28 days

For Tourists * US \$ 30

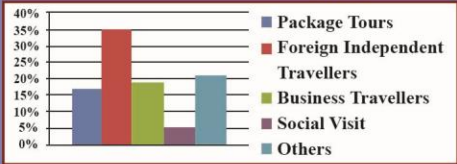

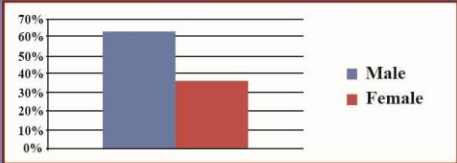

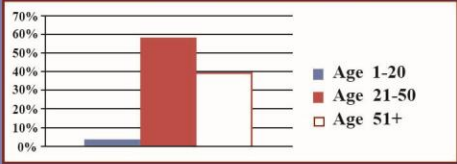
Tourist Arrivals by Gender Group
