

Construction of US\$35 million Russey Keo bridge 89% Complete

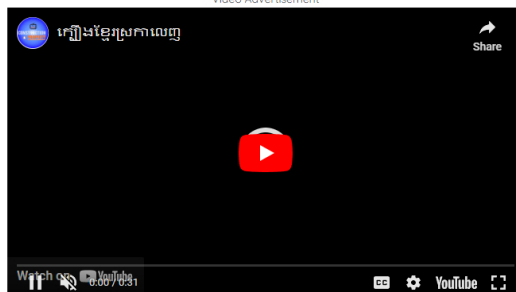


As of early December, the construction of the Russey Keo cable bridge across the Tonle Sap River has been 89% completed, according to the Department of Public Works and Transport of Phnom Penh on 5 December.

Worth US\$35 million, the new concrete cable-stayed bridge across the Tonle Sap is 20.5 metres wide and 500 metres long. The project is scheduled to be completed in April 2023. ([Read more](#))

Besides the bridge, the developer OCIC is also building a new flyover connecting NR5 to the starting point of the new bridge. The project will cost about US\$9.7 million with construction scheduled for completion in 15 months. ([Read more](#))
