THE MINERAL INDUSTRY OF CAMBODIA

In 2017 and 2018, the production of mineral commodities primarily cement, gravel, salt, sand, and stone—represented only a minor part of the economy of Cambodia (Open Development Cambodia, 2018). The legislative framework for the mineral sector in Cambodia is provided by the Law on Mineral Resource Management and Exploitation of July 13, 2001, and the Sub-Decree on Management of Mineral Exploration and Industrial Mining Licenses of May 5, 2016. Data on mineral production are in table 1. Table 2 is a list of major mineral industry facilities.
