

### JICA provides concessional loan for Siem Reap water supply expansion project

The Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) has decided to provide approximately \$58 million in concessional loan to the Royal Government of Cambodia for a project to expand water supply capacity



The additional concessional loan agreement was signed by Aun Pornmoniroth, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Economy and Finance, and Ms. Kamei Haruko, Chief Representative of JICA Cambodia Office, in a ceremony held virtually on Oct. 21.

The project aims to build a water treatment plant with a capacity of producing 600,000 cubic metres of clean water a day, which is sourced from the Tonle Sap Lake, according to the ministry's press release, adding that the project also includes the construction of a pumping station network and water distribution pipeline system.



The ministry stated that the achievements of the project will contribute significantly to helping the Royal Government of Cambodia to achieve the National Strategic Development Plan on water supply through the support for the Siem Reap Water Supply Authority.
