1. Background

The Pentagonal Strategy - Phase I of the Royal Government of Cambodia of the Seventh Legislature of the National Assembly added "technology" as a key priority to the four existing key priorities of the Rectangular Strategy and determined Pentagon 5 for the development of digital economy and society. It reflects that the government identified technology, especially digital technology, as a priority for the nation's economic and social development. Among the emerging digital technologies, artificial intelligence (AI) is the most eminent technology bringing both opportunities and risks, which requires strategic governance. Cambodia Digital Economy and Society Policy Framework 2021-2035 and Cambodia Digital Government Policy 2022-2035 have identified key policy measures and priority actions related to AI which demonstrate the forward-looking of policymakers; nevertheless, the rapid proliferation, development, and adoption of AI in general and generative AI in particular, need all relevant stakeholders to quickly reassess to keep up with the regional and global landscape.

Since the first half of 2024, the Ministry of Post and Telecommunications (MPTC) has conducted scientific research and prepared the draft National Artificial Intelligence Strategy. In the process, to assess Cambodia's readiness in AI adoption and development ethically, Cambodia Academy of Digital Technology (CADT) and UNESCO, supported by MPTC, commenced the ethics of AI readiness assessment in Cambodia in November 2024, using the UNESCO's Ethics of AI RAM methodology, a universal principle widely recognized and used in more than 60 countries around the globe. The key findings of this assessment have been incorporated into the draft National AI Strategy, and the first draft was issued in February 2025.

Through the collaboration and support from the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP), the first draft was consulted with the Asia-Pacific Digital Technical Network twice. The draft was subsequently reviewed and revised through a two-day deep-dive workshop in early April in Phnom Penh and 10 bilateral and multilateral consultation meetings with all relevant ministries and institutions.

As of the end of May 2025, the official report of the Ethics of AI Readiness Assessment has been concluded, while the draft National AI Strategy has been revised to version 4 after incorporating inputs from relevant ministries and institutions.







2. Purpose of the program

The national workshop on the draft National AI Strategy aims to:

- Launch and disseminate the country report on the Ethics of AI Readiness Assessment in Cambodia.
- Discuss and validate inputs provided by ministries and agencies, as well as collect remaining inputs.
- Collect inputs from all relevant stakeholders, including private sectors, academia, and civil society.
- Discuss to collectively identify key priority actions to develop a comprehensive and actionable national AI strategy aiming at promoting AI adoption and governance at the national level.
- Mobilize all relevant stakeholders into the implementation of the national AI strategy once it is adopted.
