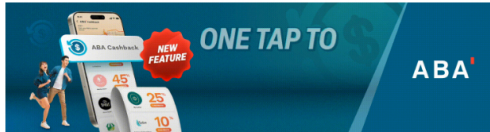


A truck carrying garment workers hit a tree in Kampong Speu province. Police

Twenty-one garment workers this morning were injured when a truck they were traveling in hit a tree in Kraing Chek commune, Oudong district, Kampong Speu province.



Police said that the accident occurred this morning when the truck driven by Thol Chhay, 22, lost control, swerved off, and hit a tree on the roadside.

Police rushed to the scene and rescued injured workers, noting that six of them sustained serious injuries.

The victims have received treatment at a private hospital and the Oudong District Referral Hospital.
