

- Advance policy dialogue on NRM at the national level




# Project Achievements

# Project Achievements – Success Story

## *Indigenous youths' improvement on mobile report*

Being trained to use a smartphone to report reflects the view of indigenous youth.

*"This training is very significant for me since I could use it to empower my community and share with outsiders who we are and what we are living with."*

September 2022 – Lao Bundinh is a Jarai indigenous youth. He was born in a rural area of Phork Thom village, Phork Nhay commune, Ouyadav district, Ratanakiri province, and he has lived there for 27 years. He did not have much knowledge of story writing as well as photos and video shooting. However, he would like to share his daily life as an indigenous youth, livelihood, and culture as well as the environment in his community with other people through social media.

Until when he got to know about the mobile report training organized by CIPL in collaboration with ODC, he has the chance to learn what he like and waiting for. He joined the mobile report training which aims to build the capacity of indigenous youths on how to use a mobile phone to report on natural resources management by writing stories and using photos as the evidence-based mechanism on 21<sup>st</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2022 in Ratanakiri province. It required him to put more effort and time to improve his skills.

His commitment to sharing what is happening within his community inspired him to persevere through the challenges. Currently, he can write a story and edit a video to share on the social media platform. He feels very thankful for the organizer giving him an opportunity to learn what he always wishes to. He posted his own [video](#), "Finished the mobile report training on environment, video shooting, and video editing from CIPL, I could do some practices" to illustrates the beauty of the forest, environment, and livelihood of his community on social media.

## *Indigenous youth become confident in expressing himself*

Participating in discussions and learning about current issues boosts indigenous youth's confidence.

*"Because I participated in various activities and training, I now feel more confident in expressing myself and my community."*

December 2022 – Mong Samut is a 22-year-old Brao indigenous youth. He was born in a remote area located in Sieng Say village, Ta Veaeng Kraom commune, Ta Veaeng district, Ratanakiri province. This is where he is living with his family. As an indigenous youth, he had few opportunities for further education. He was a young farmer without a confident expression and so preoccupied with his job that he was unaware of the situation outside of the community. However, land and forestry issues have arisen in his community. He wishes to seek assistance and share these conflicts and challenges with others to obtain protective intervention.




Mr. Mong Samut (Red shirt) participating in the meeting on identify topics on NRM and land conducted by CIPL in his village center


Until he gets to know Open Development Cambodia (ODC) and Conserve Indigenous Peoples Languages (CIPL) organizations, he has a chance to learn and participate in various activities and training such as mobile report training, data visualization and storytelling, and identifying topics on natural resource, land, and environment. He has learned how to identify problems, edit videos, and gain basic knowledge of natural resources, land, and forestry. Even though his knowledge cannot be compared to that of people living in cities, he is dedicated and always pays more attention to the lesson and discussions.

The desire to express the community's issues and challenges keep him go on. He is ready for sharing to others what is going on in his community, while also gathering information from others to share with his own. If given the opportunity, he pledges to open his community's culture, livelihood, and issues through what he learned.
