Of Registration, Application Form (Fee of license) Renewal, Transfer of Mineral Resource License, Annual Land Rental in Concession Areas for Mineral Exploration and/or Exploitation and Royalty on Mineral Resources

DECIDES

Article 1:

Natural persons, legal entities that submit application or holders of the mineral resource licenses shall pay the State the fees as set in the following tables:
