

Five former China Project employees were granted safe passage back to the Philippine after being released from the compound, sources familiar with the matter told Khmer Times.



The identities of the individuals have been withheld.

The Philippine Embassy in Phnom Penh declined to comment on the matter.

"There were 67 distressed Filipinos in Cambodia on the flight, including two minors, 12 senior citizens and one pregnant woman, who were affected by the pandemic and lost their jobs or were stranded in Cambodia," the embassy said in a statement.
